Hillsides partially underlain by one major and other lesser basalt outcrop ledges; flat areas of sub-cropping basalt (representing the top of bedrock); and extensive areas largely covered with cobbles, boulders, and blocks of loose, detached basalt on and in the soil horizon.

Loose, detached basalt pieces measuring from less than 0.5 ft. to 5 ft. in long-dimension. Typically, the stone is dark gray but with brownish to lavender to red-brown colors on weathered surfaces. Some of the stone is greenish to orange lichen coloration; even more has surficial growths of rather nondescript, rounded 'clumps' of gray-colored moss.

Quantity Estimates (of detached material, not including considerable resources of ledge-outcrops):

1. Usable (detached) stone cover over 20 acres; pieces average 1.5 x 1.2 x 1.0 ft.; average thickness is 1.0 ft.; yields 156,816 cu. Ft., or 12,545 tons at 160 lbs./cu. Ft.
2. Larger, better landscapers (would be included within above) 4% coverage of such pieces over aggregate 12-acre area; pieces average 2.5 x 1.5 x 1.2 ft.; average thickness is 1.2 ft. yields 25,091 cu. Ft. or 2,007 tons.

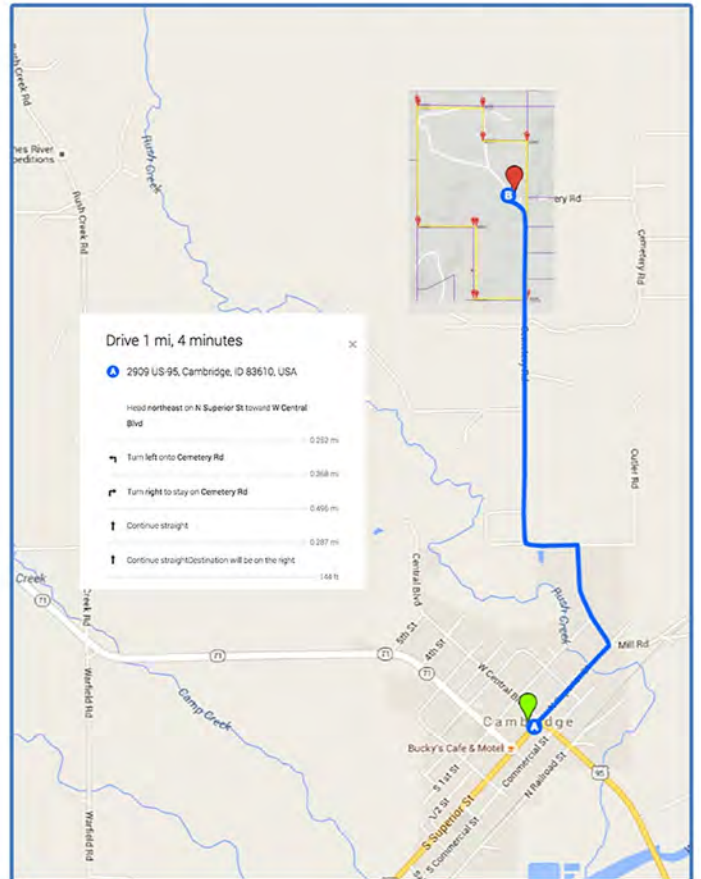
